Location: Cuyahoga Community College Fire Training Academy, 11000 Pleasant Valley Road, Parma OH

Date: September 6-8, 2017

Course Times: 8:00 am – 4:30 pm (all three days); lunch is not provided

Cost: \$650 if registered on or before September 1, \$700 after September 1

CEUs: International Society of Arboriculture (ISA) Certified Arborists, Utility Specialists, Municipal Specialists, and Tree Workers will be eligible to receive CEUs for the three-day course

Equipment Requirements: Participants are required to bring personal protection equipment and their regular climbing gear (harness and line)

Course Description: The Emergency Readiness and High Angle Rescue with Advanced Trauma Care course will educate tree climbers and/or aerial lift operators in the most likely scenarios where they may have to respond to an emergency. Specific training topics include:

- Safety, teamwork, communication risk management and OSHA/ANSI protocols
- PPA and PPE use, fit, inspection and retirement performance criteria
- OSHA and ANSI rescue protocols and requirements
- Tree climbing using MRS, SRS and spike climbing systems, as well as lines, knots, hitches, prussics and rope tools
- Understanding load forces of anchors: single, double and multi anchor loading
- Self-rescue management, trauma care, first aid, CPR and rescue protocols
- Tree climbing: ascending, positioning, redirecting and descent systems as they relate to rescue
- Climber assessment, packaging, stabilization and extrication

Age of Majority: Each participant must be over the age of majority in the state in which the course is being held

Payment Terms: A minimum of \$100 is required to hold your space; full payment is required at least 14 days prior to the start of the course
